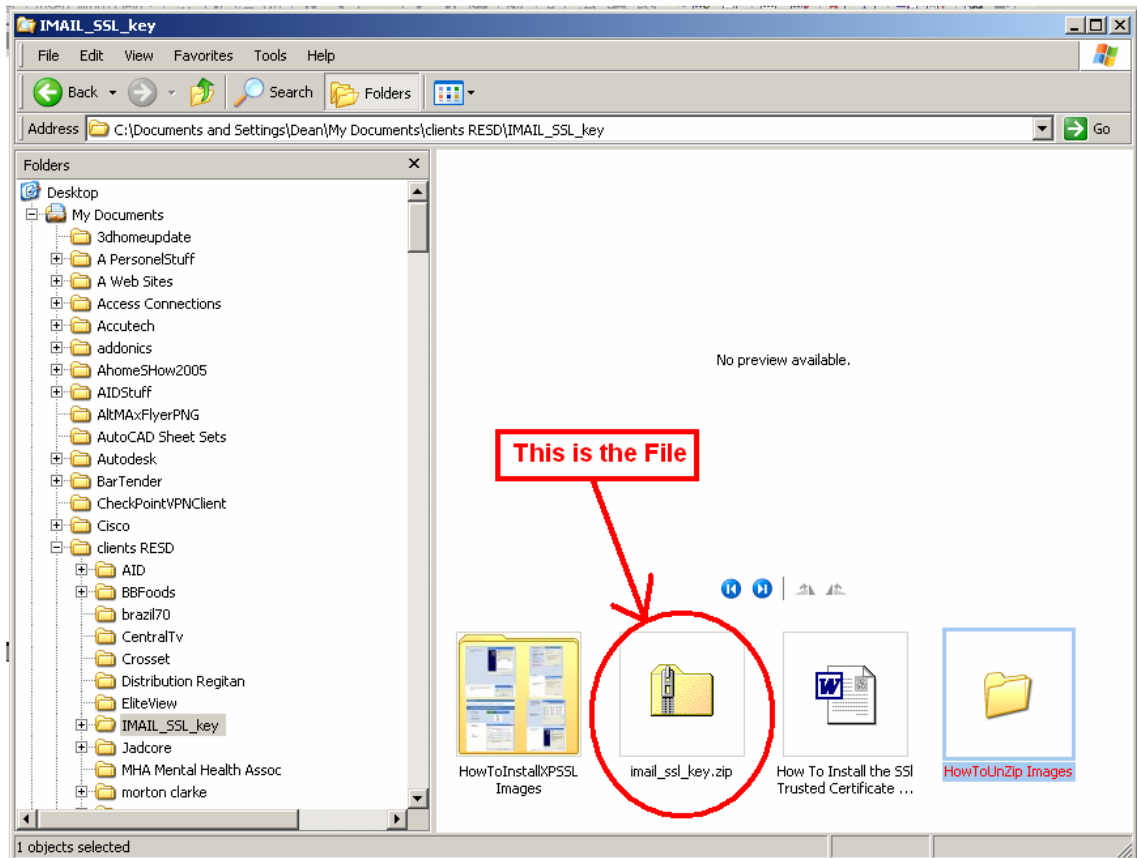


How to Un-Zip files

This document will guide you through the steps of using the windows XP extraction program. You may have a 3rd party program installed on your system like WinZip. If so, you will need to refer to the documentation that come with the 3rd party software to un-zip or extract your files.

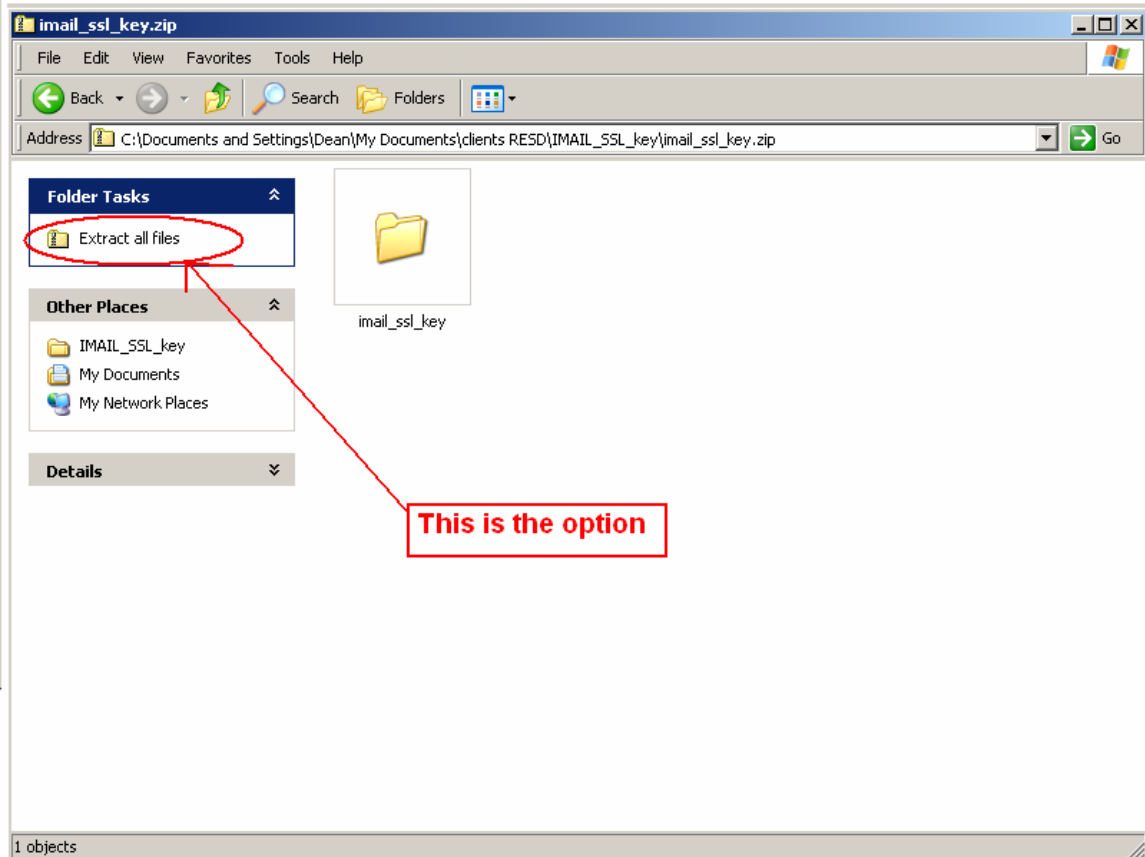

Open a windows explorer session and locate the imail_ssl_key.zip file, then double click on the file.

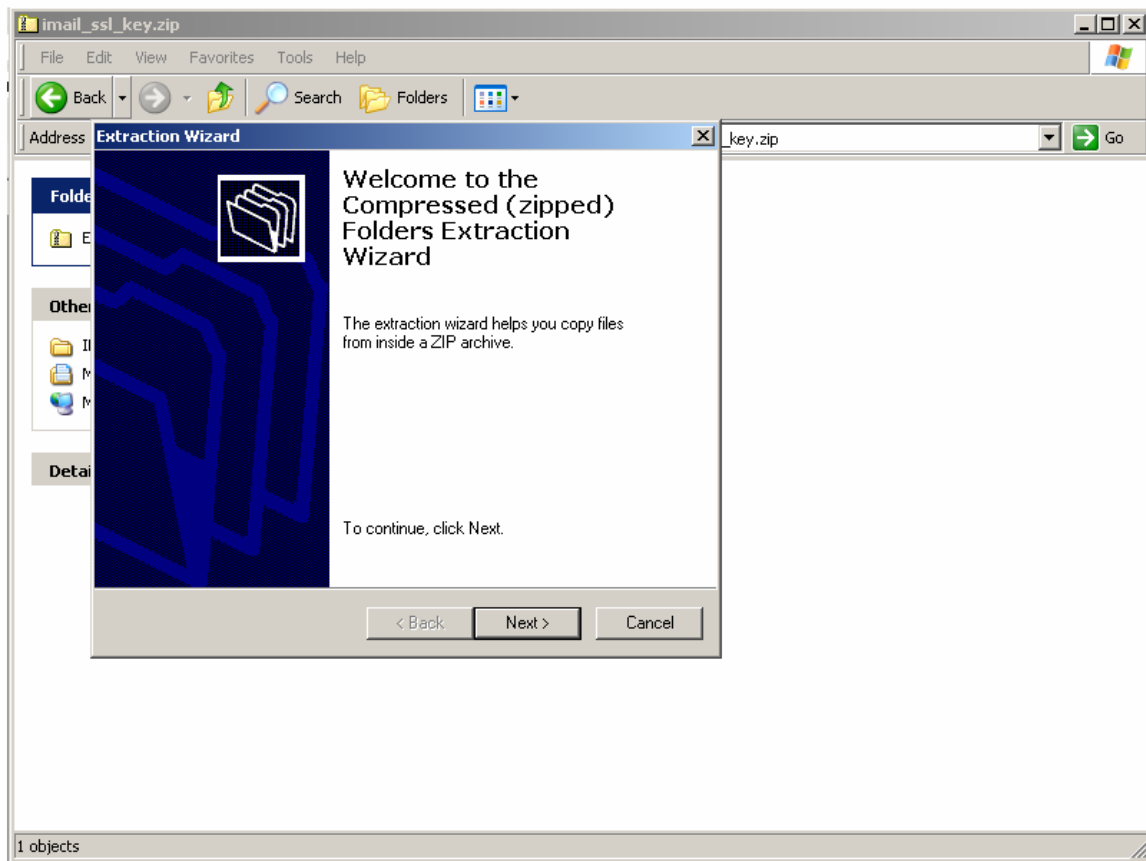


This brings up a window similar to this on Windows XP. If you have installed some other brand of compressed files software, you will get your software instead. In that case, these instructions are not the same for you and you must refer to the instructions for your compression software.

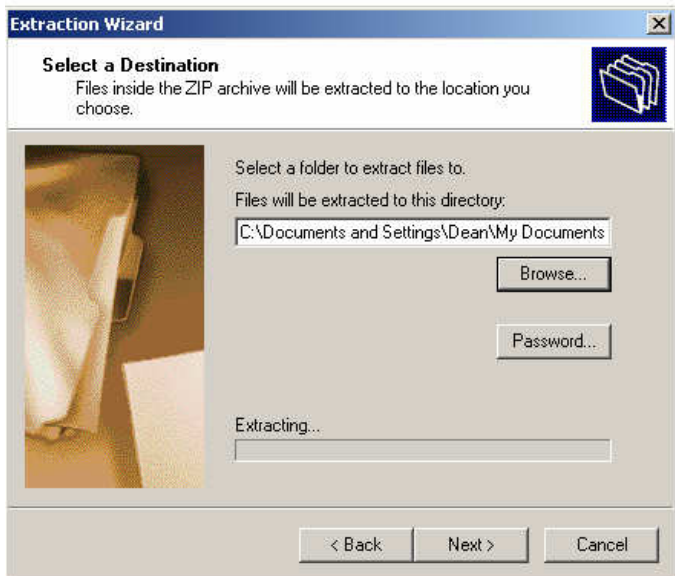
Proceed by selecting the Extract all files option on the left.



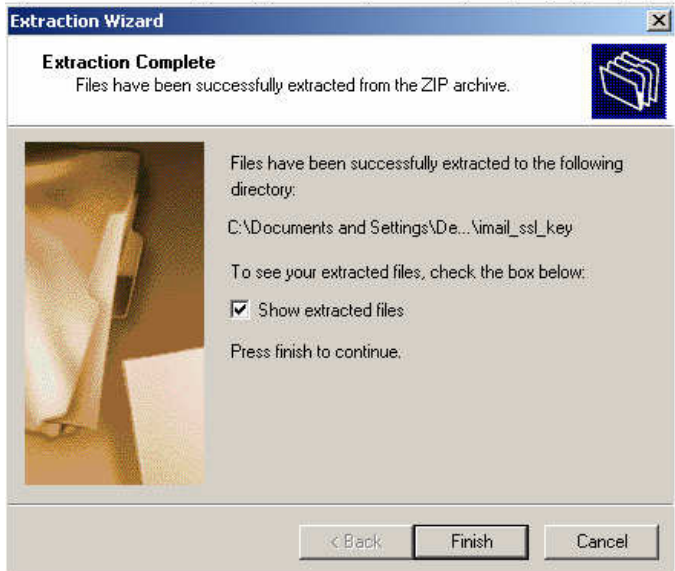
You Should get a dialog similar to this. Press next to continue.



Extract the files to a destination that you can remember.



You can use the browse button to select a location that you want the files to go to. You will need to know where that is when you install the SSL certificate.



Select finish to complete the process. It is not required to show the extracted files. So, you can uncheck the box if it is selected.
